**Timing:** Session A -Assembly at 9:00 am. Session B - Assembly at 11:30 am. Session C - Assembly at 2:15 pm. 2 ends of practice will follow each assembly (during which equipment may be inspected), followed by the FITA 18 round. Venue organisers may run a 'Head-2-Head' event before the presentation.

**Awards:** A Champion's medal and trophy will be awarded to the highest scoring British GNAS senior and junior lady and gentleman. Championship medals will be awarded according to entry numbers in the Senior and Junior Lady and Gentlemen categories. Masters and each junior age category will receive UTC medals according to entry. Entrants to the Masters classes will be eligible for the Championship. Home Nations Trophy: Highest senior male, female & junior (boy or girl) Club: Highest senior male, female & junior (boy or girl). University: Highest male & female from the same university (no trophy - awaiting donation) Couple: Highest scoring married couple.

**Other Details:** Subject to space being available other disciplines who wish to shoot may do so, but will be put on a holding register and will not know if space is available until 22nd November 2010. There will be NO awards for other disciplines except at the discretion of the venue organiser, but records may be claimed.

**Dress:** GNAS dress regulations as shown in GNAS Rule 307 will apply. **GNAS cards should be available if requested.**

**Drug Testing:** Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

**Photography:** In view of the provisions of the GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Venue Organiser on arrival. No unauthorised photography will be permitted.

**Target List:** Target lists will be sent to those sending requesting one via e-mail, but may be subject to change on the day.

**Results:** Results will be published on the GNAS web site, ([www.gnas.org/nationaltournaments/](http://www.gnas.org/nationaltournaments/) and then click on Barebow Championships), but are available via email if requested.
