From M4 Junction 43 take A465 signposted Neath. Follow this road for about 4 miles then branch left onto slip road signposted Cadoxton Aberdulais, then at roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A4109 Continue for one mile then turn right onto Ynysygerwn Avenue signposted B4242, again continue for one mile to venue on left.

From A465 Continue down A465 until Resolven, at roundabout take the 4th exit onto the B4242 turning right signposted Neath, continue 3 miles to venue on right

Juniors

Juniors (under 18) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian unless a letter is received naming another adult willing to do so (back of entry form will do). Parents must stay on the course if willing for their child to shoot without their supervision, or inform the tournament secretary if they wish to leave, providing them with a contact number.

Age Groups

Junior ages: U12, U15, U18 on the first day of the tournament. If in doubt write the child's date of birth

Veteran: Archers over 50 (exact age not necessary) may choose to shoot in the Veteran class

Senior: all adults not included in Veteran class

Pegs

Red: Compound Unlimited (all ages); all other sighted classes over 15 years old

Blue: All Unsighted classes; U15 Sighted classes excluding compound unlimited

White: Juniors under 12yrs and unsighted juniors up to the age of 15

Inexperienced adult archers may shoot from nearer pegs subject to agreement from the Tournament Organiser and Chairman of Judges. Scores obtained on these pegs will **not** be eligible for awards.
