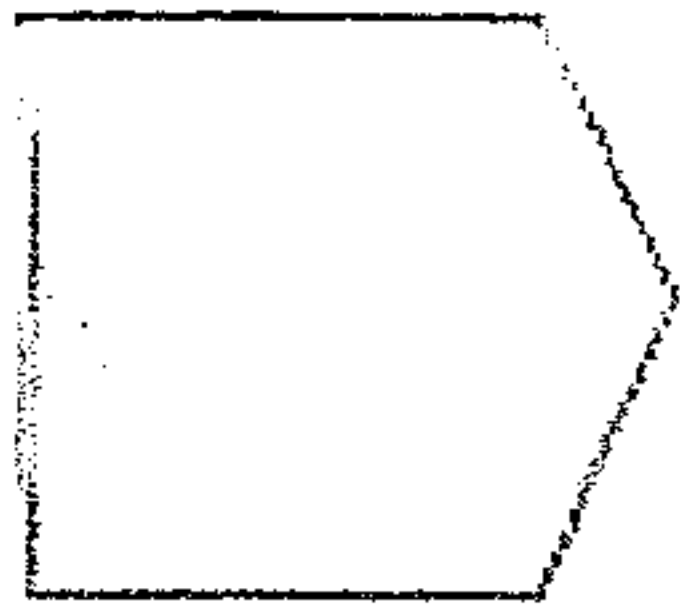

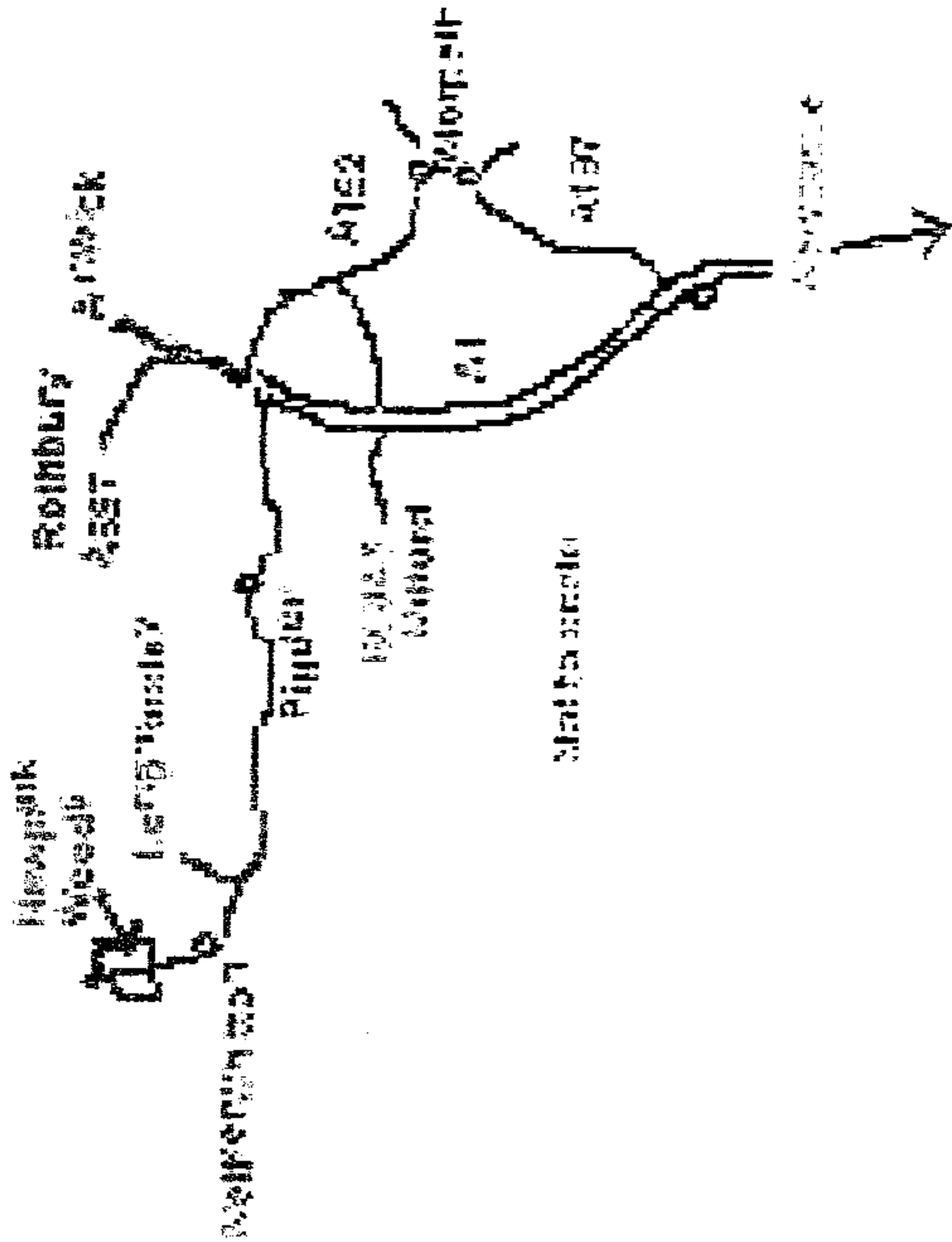

Drug testing

This is a record status shoot. Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply; if they refuse that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors must have the signed consent of a parent or guardian on the entry form, to permit drug testing if it should be required by GNAS.

Directions.

From the south. (Bypassing Morpeth)

A1 north from Newcastle. Leave on A697 for "Coldstream, Rothbury". Just after 1↓ sign turn right, sign posted Morpeth, back over the A1. Rejoin A1 South and immediately take slip road A192, "Morpeth". Turn right at mini roundabout, signed "Alnwick", go under flyover and turn left to "Pigdon and Netherwitton". Through Netherwitton (6.5 miles) and car park is 1 mile past Netherwitton, on the left. From Morpeth.

Take A192 North. At Fairmoor, go under flyover and turn left for "Pigdon and Netherwitton"

From the North.

From A1 take A192 slip road "Morpeth", turn right at mini roundabout signed "Alnwick". Go under flyover and turn left "Pigdon & Netherwitton". Through Netherwitton (6.5 miles) and car park is 1 mile past Netherwitton, on the left.
