

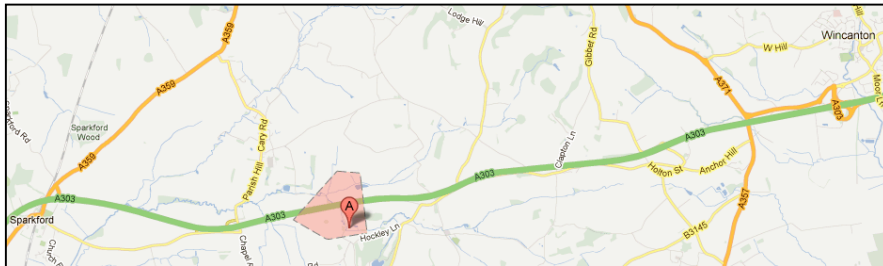
Limited camping is available on site. £5 per unit (tent, caravan or vehicle) will be charged and all monies will go to the Church Restoration Fund.

A303. After Wincanton take the first junction signposted Compton Pauncefoot(CP). Turn right towards CP. At approx. 250 metres turn right to continue parallel with A303. Follow road in to CP – Manor House & church on the right.

From the west:

A303. Follow signs for South Cadbury. At the Camelot pub, turn left (Compton Road). At T-junction with Old Rd turn left. Continue down hill to the Manor House.

This UK record status tournament will be subject to **drug testing**. Competitors approached to give a sample must comply. A refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/guardians of all juniors entering this tournament must sign the entry form to give their permission for drug testing if it is required.
