Directions

From M4 Junction 34 take A4119 signposted Rhondda. Follow this road for about 12 miles. After several roundabouts you will come to Clydach Vale roundabout, take 2nd exit and go down a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill is the Ynysydrug Roundabout, take the first exit.

Continue straight ahead and through 2 sets of traffic lights past ASDA and the Fire Station on right hand side, at the 3rd set of lights take 1st exit (signposted Ton Pentre)

After approx. 100 yards turn left, into Glyncornel Centre, keep to the left up the hill, speed limit is **5mph**. At top of the hill turn right down into Pentref Bowmen's car park

Juniors

Red: Compound Unlimited (all ages); all other sighted classes over 15 years old

Blue: All Unsighted classes; U15 Sighted classes excluding Compound Unlimited

White: Juniors under 12 years and unsighted up to the age of 15 years

Inexperienced adult archers may shoot from nearer pegs subject to agreement from the Tournament Organiser and Chairman of Judges. Scores obtained on these pegs will **NOT** be eligible for awards
