## **Directions**

From M4 Junction 34 take A4119 signposted Rhondda. Follow this road for about 12 miles; after several roundabouts you will come to Clydach Vale roundabout take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and go down a steep hill

At the bottom of the hill is the Ynysydrug Roundabout, take the first exit.

Continue straight ahead at first and second set of lights (statue of miner and wife, McDonalds, Asda on right).

At next set of lights turn left (signposted Ton Pentre).

After approx 100yds turn left, into Glyncornel Centre.

Keeping to the left, drive up the hill, speed limit **5mph**.

At the top of the hill turn right into Pentref Bowmen's car park

## **Juniors**

Juniors (under 18) must be accompanied by a parent or guardian unless a letter is received naming another adult willing to do so (back of entry form will do). Parents must stay on the course if willing for their child to shoot without their supervision, or inform the tournament secretary if they wish to leave, providing them with a contact number.

### Age Groups

**Junior ages:** U12, U15, U18 on the first day of the tournament. If in doubt write the child's date of birth

**Veteran:** Archers over 50 (exact age not necessary) may choose to shoot in the Veteran class

**Senior:** all adults not included in Veteran class

### Pegs

**Red:** Compound Unlimited (all ages); all other sighted classes over 15 years old

**Blue:** All Unsighted classes; U15 Sighted classes excluding compound unlimited

**White:** Juniors under 12yrs and unsighted juniors up to the age of 15

**Inexperienced adult archers** may shoot from nearer pegs subject to agreement from the Tournament Organiser and Chairman of Judges. Scores obtained on these pegs will **not** be eligible for awards.
