Directions

From M4 Junction 34 take A4119 signposted Rhondda. Follow this road for about 12 miles; after several roundabouts you will come to Clydach Vale roundabout take the 2nd exit and go down a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill is the Ynyscrug roundabout, take the first exit. Continue straight ahead at first and second set of lights (statue of miner and wife/ McDonalds and Asda on right). At next set of lights turn left (signposted Ton Pentre). After approx 100yds turn left, into Glynconel Centre. Drive up the hill, speed limit 5mph. At the top of the hill turn right (Environmental Centre on left) down into Pentref car park

Parents must accompany/ or shoot with their child unless a letter is received naming an adult willing to do so (back of entry form will do). Parents must stay on the course if willing for their child to shoot without their supervision, or inform the tournament secretary if they wish to leave, providing them with a contact number.
