FITA & GNAS Rules of shooting will apply. All entrants must be members of GNAS or a FITA associated organisation. Entrants may be asked to produce membership cards at registration.

Record status shoots will be liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply, if they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result.

Refreshments will be available both days.

Neither Pentref Bowmen nor Rhondda Cynon Taff can accept liability for loss or damage to person or equipment, however caused.

Junior ages: U12, U15, U18 on the first day of the tournament. If in doubt write the child's D.O.B. Veteran: anyone over 50.

PEGS

RED: Compound unlimited 12yrs or over, sighted 15yrs or over.

BLUE: Sighted (excluding compound unlimited) under 15 and unsighted 12yrs or over.

WHITE: Juniors Under 12

Inexperienced archers may shoot from nearer pegs subject to agreement from the Tournament Organiser and Chairman of Judges. Scores obtained on these pegs may not be eligible for awards.

Directions

From M4 Junction 34 take A4119 signposted Rhondda. Follow this road for about 12 miles; after several roundabouts you will come to Clydach Vale roundabout take the 2nd exit and go down a steep hill. At the bottom of the hill is the Ynyscrug roundabout, take the first exit. Continue straight ahead at first and second set of lights (statue of miner and wife/ McDonalds and Asda on right). At next set of lights turn left (signposted Ton Pentre). After approx 100yds turn left into Glyn cornel Centre. Drive up the hill to the left, speed limit 5mph. At the top of the hill turn right (Environmental Centre on left) down into Pentref Bowmen car park. Disabled parking directly outside clubhouse.

Accommodation

No camping will be available on site.

For further information on accommodation in the area please contact the tournament organiser.

Parents must accompany or shoot with their child unless a letter is received naming an adult willing to do so (back of entry form will do). Parents must stay on the course if willing for their child to shoot without their supervision, or inform the tournament organiser if they wish to leave, providing them with a contact number.
