Archers will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Entries from archers under 18 must be signed by a parent/guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.

Directions to Woodstock:

From M20, exit at Junction 7 (Maidstone/Sheerness) Take the A249 towards Sheerness. At the M2 roundabout, take the 5th exit (turning back on yourself) A249 towards Maidstone. Then take the immediate left, followed by immediate right into PETT LANE. Follow this road past the converted barn, the road will narrow and bear right, keep going, the gate will be sign posted to your right.

From the M2, exit at Junction 5 (Maidstone/Sheerness) Take the A249 towards Maidstone. Then take the immediate left, followed by immediate right into PETT LANE. Follow this road past the converted barn, the road will narrow and bear right, keep going, the gate will be sign posted to your right.
